



SPECIAL TOUCHES: INTENTIONALITY WITH OTHERS

To encourage participants as they confront the difficult topic of repentance in Week 8, introduce the concept of writing “**Love Letters from God.**” Ask each participant to take a moment to reflect on their worth and God’s unconditional love for them, even during challenging times. They can then write a letter from God’s perspective, affirming their value and reminding them of His endless grace and forgiveness.

Encourage participants to include specific scriptures that speak to their identity in Christ, such as 1 John 3:1, which emphasizes being called children of God. Once the letters are completed, invite participants to read them aloud during the class if they feel comfortable, fostering a supportive environment. This special touch reinforces the message that, no matter the challenges they face, they are always loved and valued by their Creator. Participants can keep their letters as a personal reminder of God’s love and grace as they navigate their journey forward.
